Overview

The dance minor is designed to prepare pre-professional dancers in a dynamic environment conducive to the highest caliber of both practice and scholarship. The program consists of 18 credit hours and offers a foundation in dance technique, dance history, composition, and performance.

Requirements

You must be a fully-registered UCF student with a declared major in order to audition. The dance minor program is only structured for students who have had previous dance training. We are looking for dancers who can demonstrate dance technique skills at the intermediate to advanced level.

At auditions, students will be asked to complete ballet, jazz, and tap combinations for evaluation of skill level. All dancers should be warmed-up and ready to dance prior to the audition time.

Please bring the following items to your audition:

- Headshot
- Résumé listing all dance experience (training and performance)
- Transcripts of prior college credits
- Appropriate dance attire and shoes

Students that are not at a level of technique required may still register for dance classes as long as there is space available and all pre-requisites have been met.

Students selected into the dance minor will be required to meet with program coordinator Judi Siegfried to declare the minor and course advising.
